## YMCA INTERSTATE BOYS/GIRLS BAKSETBALL TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Games to start no earlier than 5 PM Friday afternoon and conclude late afternoon Saturday
- Girls IBB Divisions are 3<sup>rd</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> Grade
- Boys IBB Divisions are 3<sup>rd</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> Grade
- Players must play on ONE team only within their grade division.
- Players may play up a grade level but can **NOT** play down a grade level
- All teams must have uniform shirts with visible numbers
- Trophies will be handed out for 1<sup>st</sup> place and medals for 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> (Dependent on bracket size)
  - \*\*4 team brackets will receive trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> and medals for 2<sup>nd</sup>
- There will be an adult spectator admission of \$7.00 PER DAY or a \$10.00 tournament pass for the weekend and a \$5.00 weekend pass for Middle School & High School Students
- Tournament T-Shirts will be sold through our online store and will be available at the YMCA prior to play if pre-ordered, otherwise shirts ordered during games can be shipped to home

### **EACH TEAM MUST PROVIDE A SCOREKEEPER OR CLOCK WORKER FOR THEIR GAME**

#### **SDHSAA basketball rules will be used along with the following exceptions**

- All games will play two 18-minute halves with a running clock. Clock will stop only during the last two minutes OF THE GAME on referee whistles for all infractions.
- Running clock will NOT stop on whistles if a team is trailing by 15 points or more
- Overtimes will be 2 minutes
- Each team is given 3 timeouts per game and one additional timeout for overtime. Timeouts DO NOT carry over to overtime (clock stops for overtime)
- Halftime will be 5 minutes
- On the 8<sup>th</sup> team foul in each half, the other team will automatically shoot 2 free throws considered to be in double bonus – Players can foul out in a game
- Games can start early if both teams are ready and agree to begin early
- 3<sup>rd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> --- no pressing at any time during the game
- 5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> --- may only press during the last 2 minutes of the game
- 5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> --- No press when ahead by 10 points or more
- 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> --- No zone defense, only man-to-man is allowed
- 7<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> --- may use zone defense
- Three-point rule applies on courts where line is marked
- All technical fouls will result in **2 points** awarded to the opposing team plus possession. Any player or coach whom receives a second personal foul will be removed from the game
- Coaches and players are responsible for players at all times off the court
- All grades will play on a 10-foot hoop
- 28.5 (Girls'/Women's Basketballs) will be used for all grades **EXCEPT** 9<sup>th</sup> Grade (Men's)
  - 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Boys can use a men's ball if both teams agree
- A team may be suspended from further play for unsportsmanlike conduct by its players, coaches, team managers, or fans. Officials will enforce a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY regarding fouls or inappropriate language or behavior

\*Criteria for Placing\*

- 1) Overall Record
- 2) Head-to-head scores
- 3) Fewest points allowed in all games
- 4) Coin toss
